



Hayesville Elementary School Bond Construction Update!

Voters passed a bond in 2018 to fund improvements across the entire district. Hayesville Elementary School will be receiving upgrades to relieve overcrowding, improve safety and security and protect public investment in Hayesville’s facility.

Highlights of the work happening for Hayesville include three new classrooms, removal of all portable classrooms, a new multipurpose fitness room, a new covered play area, cafeteria improvements, heating/ventilation system improvements and more.

The district’s project management team is currently working through the design process and preparing to hire a construction contractor. Construction is planned to begin in June at the end of the 2019-20 school year and is expected to be completed early in the fall of 2021.

Construction fences and the contractor’s portable offices will be seen on site at Hayesville as we get closer to the start of construction.

Thanks to the community’s support of the 2018 bond, Hayesville will soon have a safer learning environment with more space to support our students.
