Welcome back to school!

Things certainly look different this year. McKay was just starting to prepare for construction when the COVID-19 pandemic closed school in March of 2020. Construction has been able to continue during the last several months and contractors have made great progress.

There's still a lot of work to be done, however, and **our school will be an active construction site until the fall**. Here are some important safety instructions to remember while at McKay:

- Staff, students and visitors must **obey all posted signs, and stay out of the construction zone**. Signs, fences, and barriers are in place to make sure school operates safely and construction progresses as swiftly as possible.
- The construction crew will be actively working around campus during the school day. It may be tempting to ask the workers questions or talk with them but distracting construction workers can create a safety hazard. **Please allow workers to focus on their jobs to keep themselves and others safe.**
- There will be construction vehicle traffic around campus during the day. Please use extra caution when walking, biking or driving around McKay. Stay focused on the road and **watch for vehicles**.
- Construction contractors will park in the areas shown on the map. **The majority of parking is available for staff and students.**
- Walk paths have been established to provide a safe way to get across campus. **Please use the pathways shown in pink on the map** to travel between the main building, the temporary portable classrooms, and the bus loading area. The sidewalk from Wolverine to McKay will remain open.

Student safety is our top priority at McKay High School. Thank you for being cautious and staying safe during construction. And thank you to the Salem and Keizer communities for supporting the 2018 bond that is funding these important improvements for McKay High School.


