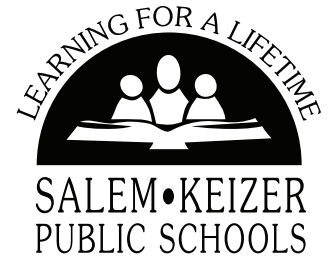


# UPDATED: 2020-21 Calendar for Parents

<b>May 31:</b>	No school and district offices are closed
<b>June 9-11:</b>	High school graduation
<b>June 17:</b>	Official last day for all students
