FAMILY BUILDING BLOCKS

Early Head Start

- Prenatal-3 years (36 months)
- Families who meet federal income guidelines, are homeless, foster children, families who receive Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), or Supplemental Social Security Income (SSI) are eligible
- Must live within the following school boundaries: Auburn, Bush, Battle Creek, Candalaria, Mary Eyre, Four Corners, Lee, Liberty, Mckinley, Marion Miller, Morningside, Pringle, Rosedale, Salem Heights, Sumpter, Washington, Wright
- Year-round program. Classroom or Home Visiting options.

COMMUNITY ACTION

Early Head Start services are available in these variations:

- Home Base (weekly home visits and twice a month family play groups)
- Locally Designed Option (two days in class per week and two home visits a month) with bus transportation whenever possible
- Full Day/Full Year for eligible working families, but with no bus service (only available through Community Action in Salem area)
- Serves expectant mothers

Teen Parent Program

- Early Head Start Child Care Partnerships services only available for Teen Parents in the Salem Keizer Teen Parent Program or Central High School Teen Parents programs.
- Full Day/Full Year: full-time care for children age 6 weeks to 3 years of working families in a Registered/Certified Child Care Home who are under a contract with Community Action to provide Early Head Start Services.
- Parent(s) must be working at least 25 hours per week during daytime hours Mon-Fri. Must be receiving or willing to apply for Employment Related Day Care (ERDC).

- Eligible for those who work in Agriculture (51% income must come from agriculture) and includes nurseries, dairy, canneries, livestock, poultry, fish, bees

- 3 - 5 years old
- 0-130% FPL
- Eligible for those who work in Agriculture (51% income must come from agriculture) and includes nurseries, dairy, canneries, livestock, poultry, fish, bees

- 6 wks - 5 years
- 0-130% FPL
- Eligible for those who work in Agriculture (51% income must come from agriculture) and includes nurseries, dairy, canneries, livestock, poultry, fish, bees
